SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Uniform Shoe

School Uniform shoes are black dress shoes (not sneakers), and solid white or black athletic sneakers, reserved for Physical Education only.

Uniform Violation

We will be strictly enforcing the school uniform policy. If a student is found to have improper uniform, a dress code violation will be given to the student. A second violation will require the parent of the student to pay \$5.00, and a third violation will attract \$10.00 fee and a letter from the parent.

A. UNIFORMS

Girls

Pre-K – Grade 2

- 1) Saint Helen yellow Peter Pan collar
- 2) Saint Helen Green plaid jumper (Knee length)
- 3) Solid color socks, black, blue, green or white no emblem
- 4) Solid black, flat bottom, closed-toe shoes, No sneakers, boots, high tops, or brand decals.
- 5) Saint Helen reversible jacket or solid blue sweater.
- 6) Saint Helen white long sleeve button down collar shirts with logo (church attire)
- 7) Saint Helen Green Plain Criss Cross Girls Tie (church attire)
- 8) Black mesh nylon gym shorts (no logo - P.E.)
- 9) Saint Helen light steel gym tee shirt with silk screen (P.E.)

Grades 3-8

- 1) Saint Helen yellow Polo Shirt (Grades 3-5) white $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve blouse (Grades 6-8)
- 2) Saint Helen V-neck pullover (Grades 6-8)
- 3) Saint Helen plaid skort
- 4) Solid color socks, black, blue, green or white no emblem
- 5) Solid black, flat bottom, closed-toe shoes, No sneakers, boots, high tops, or brand decals.
- 6) Saint Helen reversible jacket or solid blue cardigan.
- 7) Saint Helen white long sleeve button down collar shirts with logo (church attire)
Middle school shirt w/o logo
- 8) Saint Helen Green Plain Criss Cross Girls Tie (church attire)
- 9) Black mesh nylon gym shorts (no logo - P.E.)
- 10) Saint Helen light steel gym tee shirt with silk screen (P.E.)

Boys

Pre-K – Grade 5

- 1) Saint Helen yellow Polo Shirt.
- 2) Saint Helen navy blue uniform pants or shorts.
- 3) Solid, plain black leather belt with a small no brand buckle.
- 4) Solid color socks, black, blue, green or white no emblem.
- 5) Solid black, flat bottom, closed-toe shoes, No sneakers, boots, high tops, or brand decals.
- 6) Saint Helen reversible jacket with monogram or solid navy sweater.

- 7) Saint Helen white long sleeve button down collar shirts with logo (church attire)
- 8) Green plaid boys tie (church)
- 9) Back micromesh nylon gym shorts with silk screen (P.E)
- 10) Light steel gym tee shirt with silk screen (P.E.)

Grades 6 – 8

- 1) Saint Helen

neck pullover
vest.
- 3) Saint Helen
navy blue
uniform pants.
- 4) Solid, plain black leather belt with a small no brand buckle.
- 5) Solid color socks, black or white, no emblem
- 6) Solid black, flat bottom, closed-toe shoes, No sneakers, boots, high tops, or
brand decals.
- 7) Saint Helen reversible jacket with monogram or solid navy sweater.
- 8) Saint Helen white long sleeve button down collar shirts without logo (church
attire)
- 9) Green plaid boys tie (church)
- 10) Back micromesh nylon gym shorts with silk screen (P.E)
- 11) Light steel gym tee shirt with silk screen (P.E.)

B. P.E. UNIFORMS

On assigned P.E. days all students must wear the Saint Helen P.E. Uniform: Official shirt (grey), Uniform black mesh shorts, socks and solid black or white sneakers without emblems in order to participate.

C. UNIFORM REGULATIONS

1. NO ATHLETIC SHOES OF ANY KIND, other than on P.E. days.
2. Jewelry:

- a. Necklaces: One small silver or gold necklace cross/crucifix on a thin chain.
 - b. Bracelets: No bracelets, or ankle bracelets allowed
 - c. Earrings: Only one pair of small earrings, worn on the lobe, is permitted for girls. Boys are not permitted to wear earrings.
 - d. No watches with alarms.
 - e. No costume jewelry.
3. No make-up, nail polish, or acrylic nails.
 4. No body piercings and/or tattoos.
 5. Undershirts must be solid white or black only. Colored shirts are not permitted.
 6. Boys' and girls' shirts must be tucked in. Pants must be worn with a belt and a proper fit. They are to be worn at the waist, not baggy or slouching at the ankles. Waistband and belt must be visible.
 7. School uniforms may not be cut, sewn, or altered in any way.
 8. Solid black, green, blue or white socks should always be worn. Shoes must be completely laced and tied.
 9. Hair styles are to be appropriate for school.
 - a. Boys: hair must be kept short, one length, and clean cut. Hair may not be spiked or braided. Hair may not be shaved around the hairline or may not be worn shaggy or long over the eyes or ears, sideburns may not be shaved in a thin line.
 - b. Girls and boys: hair may not be colored in any way. Hair must be kept away from the face. Hairstyles should not be outlandish as to cause a distraction (to be determined by the Principal)
 10. While on school grounds and at all school events, students must be in proper uniform.
 11. If an emergency arises necessitating an incomplete uniform, a note must be submitted to the homeroom teacher, stating the reason and giving the date when the student will return in complete uniform attire. If a student does not bring a note, the parent/guardian will be called to bring the proper uniform or to correct the infraction.
 12. Not wearing the proper uniform is grounds for disciplinary action.

D. COLD WEATHER ATTIRE

Girls: A plain white or black long sleeve turtleneck or cotton shirt may be worn *under* the shirt (younger students) or blouse (older students) and/or solid white or black tights or knee-high socks.

Boys: A plain white or black long sleeve cotton shirt may be worn under the official uniform shirt.

E. OUT-OF-UNIFORM DRESS CODE

On out of Uniform Days, students must be dressed appropriately for a Catholic school setting. Any students wearing inappropriate clothing will be asked to call the parent to bring his/her school uniform and may be subject to disciplinary action.

1. Girls' shorts, skirts, or dresses must be of modest length and proper fit (not tight).
2. Spaghetti strap, tank, bare midriff, strapless, and halter tops are not permitted. Wearing a sweater to cover up this infraction is not permitted.
3. No pajamas.
4. No make-up.
5. Boys' may not wear earrings.
6. Boys' pants or shorts must be worn at the waist and may not be excessively baggy.
7. No backless shoes.

Students may not be out of uniform On church days or while on field trips unless stated by the organizing teacher.
